



Coronavirus (Covid-19) Customer/Visitor Questionnaire

In light of the rapidly evolving Coronavirus pandemic, and the increasing numbers of UK citizens affected, PD Ports has implemented a short questionnaire for all visitors to our UK sites to ensure the Health and Safety of all employees, customers and visitors.

What to expect when visiting us:

The site you are visiting has been risk-assessed and has been issued with a PP Ports COVID19 compliant certificate. This means that measures have been taken to ensure that the building meets the requisite standard in line with government guidance. Rooms have been sanitised and social distancing measures must be practised. There is no requirement to wear a face mask unless you feel more comfortable by doing so.

Before visiting, you are required to confirm the following:

That you are not displaying COVID19 symptoms namely: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste.

That you do not co-habit with anyone displaying COVID19 symptoms or who has self-isolated.

All site visitors are expected to follow increased levels of personal hygiene:

- Wash your hands on arrival and departure
- Wash your hands after using the rest room
- Where possible carry and use hand sanitiser
- Avoid shaking hands and physical contact
