Geo-Technical Survey

A geo-technical survey programme is planned to commence at Teesside Offshore Wind Farm, weather permitting the start date will be 17th April 2021 for 6 days , subject to weather. Scope of works will involve the vessel MV Elysse undertaking multi-beam bathymetry, echosounder and side scan sonar surveys within the Wind farm and export cable route. (Chart 1).
