An opportunity has arisen for the post of Harbour Police Sergeant, based at Teesport House, Tees Dock in Middlesbrough. The Harbour Police Sergeant will report to the Harbour Police Inspector. They are responsible for the operational deployment, performance, development and adherence to professional standards and the code of ethics of themselves and Harbour Police constables, ensuring that staff are deployed to support organisational goals, including :-

- the prevention, investigation and detection of crime
- the timely and appropriate response to incidents
- engaging with customers and stakeholders within the port community
- operational planning and problem solving
- maintaining the very highest standards of policing

You will work 12-hour shifts on a rota system, on a 4 on 4 off basis, providing 7-day, 24-hour coverage averaging 177.5 hours per month.

The Candidate

- Served as a substantive Police Sergeant for a minimum of 3 years within a Home Office force (within the last 12 months)
- Be able to pass the Home Office fitness test and complete personal safety training annually.

- Proficient in the use of Police IT systems.
- Be relied upon to work with minimum supervision.
