RECREATIONAL USE OF TEES BAY - 2022

PD Teesport hereby gives notice that, Spherical Buoys have been laid in Tees Bay for yacht racing and other recreational events by Tees and Hartlepool Yacht Club in the following approximate positions:

- WNW of Tees North in position: 54°40.4'N, 001°07.4'W Yellow Buoy
- WSW of Tees 3 in position: 54°39.3'N, 001°08.6'W Yellow Buoy
- Off Seaton Beach in position: 54°39.8'N, 001°10.1'W Yellow Buoy

- SW of Hartlepool Channel in positions: 54°41.4'N, 001°11.1'W Yellow Buoy
54 41.2 N 001 11.4' W Yellow Buoy
54°41.1'N, 001°11'W Yellow Buoy
54°40.8'N, 001°11.1'W Yellow Buoy

Events generally take place in the area NW of the Tees Fairway and south of the Heugh, Sunday 1000-1400 hours and Wednesday evenings 1800-2100 hours April to October. Occasional events on Saturday afternoons.

Winter events are held on alternate Sundays November - February.

Yachts are not permitted in the Tees or Hartlepool buoyed channels while racing.

Events which involve crossing the Tees proceeding SE to Saltscar or Whitby or North of Longscar Cardinal Buoy are as follows:

Sunday 04 September	1030 - 1500 hours	Mark A Race

Yachts will generally use VHF Channel M2 while racing.
