The Role

The main responsibility of a Shipwright is to maintain and repair PD Teesport vessels including survey and pilot craft, whilst also maintaining and repairing conservancy wharfs and buildings. This role will require someone who is prepared to work in all weather conditions and carry out physical lifting.
