CORONAVIRUS COVID-19

PD Teesport hereby gives notice that the following requirement now applies to all vessels visiting the Ports of Tees and Hartlepool.

Under UK and International Health Regulations, ships entering port are normally required to submit a Maritime Declaration of Health only when there has been an occurrence on board that may affect public health.

Due to COVID-19, additional requirements to submit a Maritime Declaration of Health will now apply.

Please ensure that a Maritime Declaration of Health is completed and conveyed to River Tees Port Health Authority and Tees VTS, if anyone on board presents with a confirmed case of Covid-19.

If a vessel has a confirmed case of COVID-19 onboard the following applies:

- If the vessel requires the services of a Tees Bay Pilot, the Bridge Team and all other essential crew involved in the pilotage operations must ensure negative Covid-19 test results are returned within 6 hours prior to pilot boarding, with the results promulgated to TEES VTS.
- The berth operator is informed and acceptance for the vessel to berth is confirmed.
- If the vessel is using port waste reception facilities, the service provider is informed.
- If the vessel is boarded by any personnel, that the person/service provider is informed.
