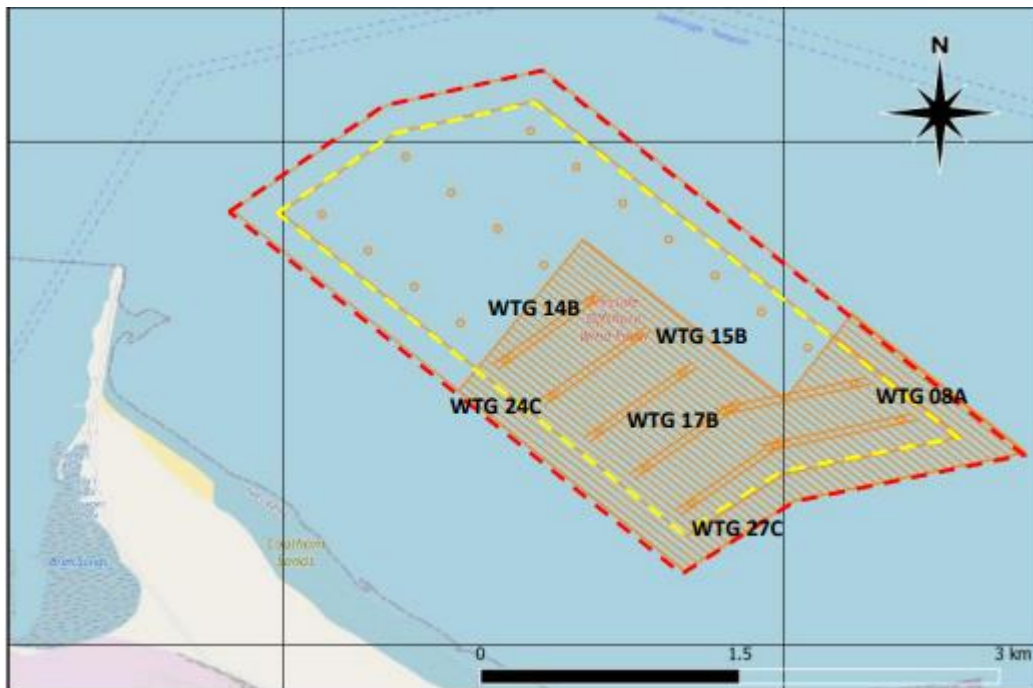

Important Notice to All Marine Users

Geophysical Survey

A geo-physical survey programme is planned to commence within the south half of the Teesside Offshore Wind Farm (see Chart 1). The start date will be 03rd April 2023 for 4 days, subject to weather. Scope of works will involve the vessel MV Elysse undertaking multi-beam bathymetry and side scan sonar surveys.
