MARITIME SANCTION AGAINST THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION AND THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS

PD Teesport hereby gives notice to Masters, Agents, Charterers and Ship Operators of all vessels, which include commercial, fishing and leisure vessels, that the following Regulations now apply:

On 5 July 2022, with immediate effect, the Department for Transport issued updated guidance for UK Ports covering Maritime Sanctions against the Russian Federation and the Republic of Belarus.

The Regulations require that ports must not provide a ship with access to a port in the UK if they know, or have reasonable cause to suspect, that the ship is:

- 1. a ship owned, controlled, chartered or operated by a designated person;
- 2. a ship owned, controlled, chartered or operated by persons connected with Russia or Belarus;
- 3. a ship flying the flag of Russia or Belarus;
- 4. a ship registered in Russia or Belarus;
- 5. a specified ship.

The Port continues to work with stakeholders to identify vessels that fall within the above category and take appropriate action.
