RECREATIONAL USE OF TEES BAY

PD Teesport hereby gives notice that, Spherical Buoys have been laid in Tees Bay for yacht racing and other recreational events by Tees and Hartlepool Yacht Club in the following approximate positions:

Races generally take place in the area NW of Tees North Buoy and S of the Heugh. These are held on Sundays, Wednesday evenings and occasional Saturdays from April to October. Winter races are held on alternate Sundays from November to February.

Yachts are not permitted in the Tees or Hartlepool buoyed channels while racing; however, the Wind Farm Race, scheduled to take place at 1030 hours on Sunday 07 September is expected to cross the Tees Approach Channel.

Yachts will generally use VHF Channel M2 while racing.

<u>NOTE</u>: Owners, Agents and Charterers should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to Masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.

Radar, AIS, CCTV, Telephone and VHF Channels are recorded 24/7.
